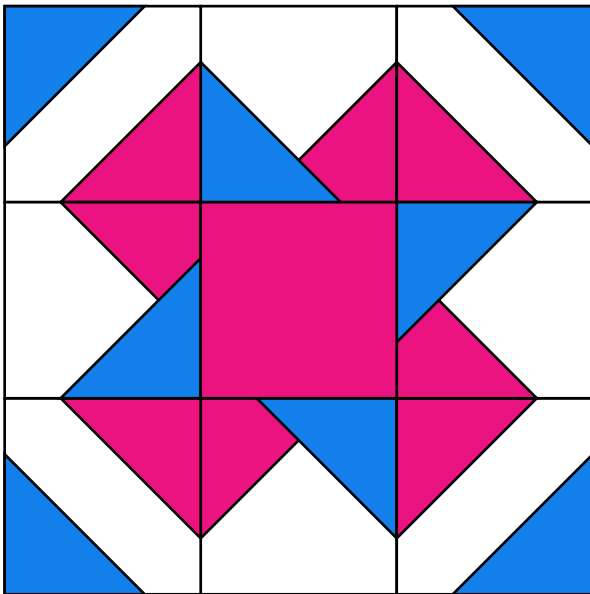


Nine Patch with a Twist

FAT QUARTER GYPSY



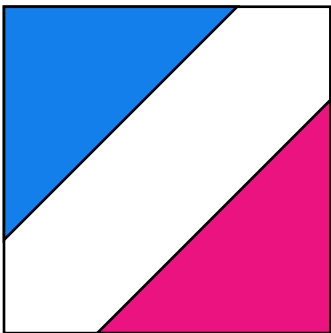
Cutting:

White: Cut [8] 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Pink: Cut [1] 3-1/2" x 3-1/2", [8] 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Blue: Cut [8] 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

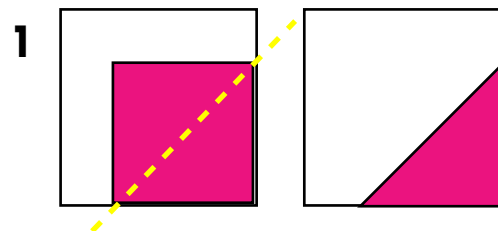
A Units:



Make 4

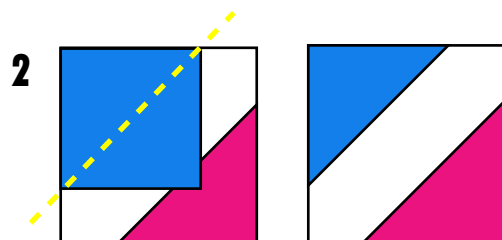
Step 1:

Sew one 2-1/2" Pink square in the lower right corner of a 3-1/2" White square, right sides together. Stitch across the diagonal, press to White and trim extra fabric from corner.



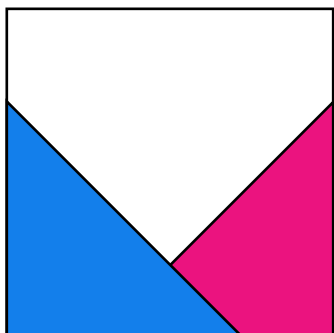
Step 2:

Sew one 2-1/2" Blue square in the upper left corner, right sides together. Stitch across the diagonal, press to Blue and trim extra fabric from corner.



Make a total of 4 A units.

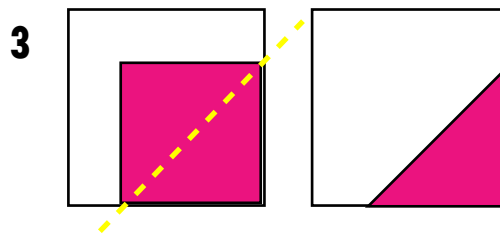
B Units:



Make 4

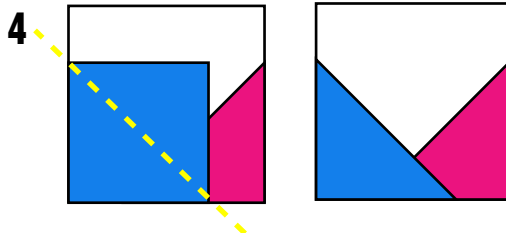
Step 3:

Sew one 2-1/2" Pink square in the lower right corner of a 3-1/2" White square, right sides together. Stitch across the diagonal, press to Pink and trim extra fabric from corner.



Step 4:

Sew one 2-1/2" Blue square in the lower left corner, right sides together. Stitch across the diagonal, press to Blue and trim extra fabric from corner.



Make a total of 4 B units.

Assemble Block:

Arrange A units, B units and 3-1/2" Pink square according to Diagram 5.

Sew Rows together.

Press rows 1 & 3 to the A units.

Press row 2 to the center Pink square.

Sew rows together, pressing seams as desired.

Finished Size: 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" (including seam allowance).
