
You will need:

#CPO28 Witch's Gallery Pattern

FQG I 22 Stacking Pop-Up Pattern

FQG I 23 Medium 8" Pop-Up Refill

Two I" orange buttons, stabilizer and fabric



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FQ-Gypsy-Pop-Up-ideas



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Directions: Use pillow applique templates at 80%

2 Orange Buttons, Stabilizer Notions: 12" x 12" Cutting: White:

Orange: Cut (2): 1" x 8" for sides,

Cut (1): $1-\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8-\frac{1}{2}$ " for top

& Cut (1): 1" x $8-\frac{1}{2}$ " for bottom

Halloween: Cut (2): $9-\frac{1}{2}$ " H x $9-\frac{1}{2}$ " W &

Cut (1): 4" x 20" strap

Stabilizer: Cut (1): 4" x 20" for strap

- 1. Applique witch to white block.
- 2. Measuring from 3/4" from top of the witch's hat, trim the appliqued block to 8" high. Center the block and cut it $7-\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.
- 3. Stitch orange side borders, and then top and bottom borders to witch block.
- **4.** Stitch black $9-\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9-\frac{1}{2}$ " sections to sides of bordered witch block.



Final Size: 9-1/2" x 26-1/2"

- 5. For straps, iron stabilizer onto back of 4×20 " Halloween fabric. Fold short edges in about $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Fold long edges toward center of wrong side of strap, and then fold strap in half. Top-stitch.
- 6. Tack to sides of Pop-Up with an orange button.

To make the pop-up, replace 'Outer Fabric rectangle' in Cutting Instructions with pieced outer fabric section. Apply Stabilizer after piecing blocks and strips together. Trim to size. Assemble Pop-Up using FQG122 Stacking Pop-Up pattern. Cut Ties/Loops from Inside Fabric. FAT QUARTER GYPSY
